The complaint should be accompanied with a DD for Rs.300/- for each question challenged by the candidates. The DD should be drawn from any branch of a nationalised bank in favour of the Director, LBS Centre payable at Thiruvananthapuram. If the complaint/complaints regarding a question or questions is/are found genuine the fee remitted for that question/questions will be refunded to the complainant.
